

Mandatory Water Conservation

As Water Treatment Plant#1 is being shut down for the Water Treatment Plant Expansion Project, the District's water production will not be able to meet all the water demands of its customers. Therefore, beginning September 1 there will only be two (2) allowable days for irrigation. The North community may irrigate Monday and Friday, the South, Village, & Commercial may irrigate on Tuesday and Saturday. Watering times are from 12am to 10am only. No watering schedule increases (extra minutes) are permissible on designated watering days. Conservation will be enforced as follows:

Violation	Penalty
First	Personal or written notification of the violation
Second	Written notification and issuance of a notice to correct
Third	Issuance of an administrative penalty of \$100
Fourth	Issuance of a penalty of \$200
Fifth	Issuance of a penalty of \$500
Final	Disconnected water service and/or other penalties as provided in the notice of violation and as determined by the General Manager.

The less water we use now means the more we will have available next year, which is especially important should the drought continues. If our reservoirs stay fuller, it will save on pumping costs from the river for next year. We must also comply with the State's Emergency Drought Regulations.

Some Wasteful Uses of Water

- Water flowing away from a property caused by excessive application(s) of water.
- Hosing down hardscape such as sidewalks and driveways.
- Allowing water fixtures or heating or cooling devices to leak or discharge water.
- Maintaining or discharging from ponds, waterways, decorative basins or swimming pools without water recirculation devices or with known leaks, both seen and unseen.
- Continued operation of an irrigation system that applies water to an impervious surface or that is in disrepair.
- Use of a water hose not equipped with a control nozzle capable of completely shutting off the flow of water except when positive pressure is applied.
- Irrigation of lawns or landscaping when it is raining.
- Irrigating lawns or landscaping outside the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m., with the exception of drip irrigation or hand watering, as otherwise authorized pursuant to this Section, unless a variance is granted by the General Manager.
- Using potable water from the District's water system for compaction, dust control or other construction purposes without first obtaining approval from the General Manager as provided in Section 7.07 and a meter from the District.
